

YO BABY! BIBS



1. Press the fabric, then place the flannel on a flat surface. Both sides of the flannel are the same, so it doesn't matter which side is up. Place the printed fabric on top of the piece of flannel with the right side of the printed fabric down. The wrong side of the fabric will be facing you, and on it will be the outline of a bib.



2. Pin around the traced bib.



3. Starting at the side of the bib, sew on the traced line all the way around the bib, stopping about two inches before your starting point. Be sure to lock your stitches at the beginning and end.



4. Trim the excess fabric close to the stitching line (1/8 to 1/4 inch) all the way around the bib.



- 5. Turn the bib right side out, through the open space in the side.
- 6. Working all the way around the bib, carefully push out all the edges and curves, rolling the fabric between your fingers. Press the bib flat, folding the seam allowance at the opening to the inside.



7. Insert the Sew Good Goods tag into the opening in the side of the bib and pin shut.



8. Topstitch very close to the edge of the bib, all the way around.
